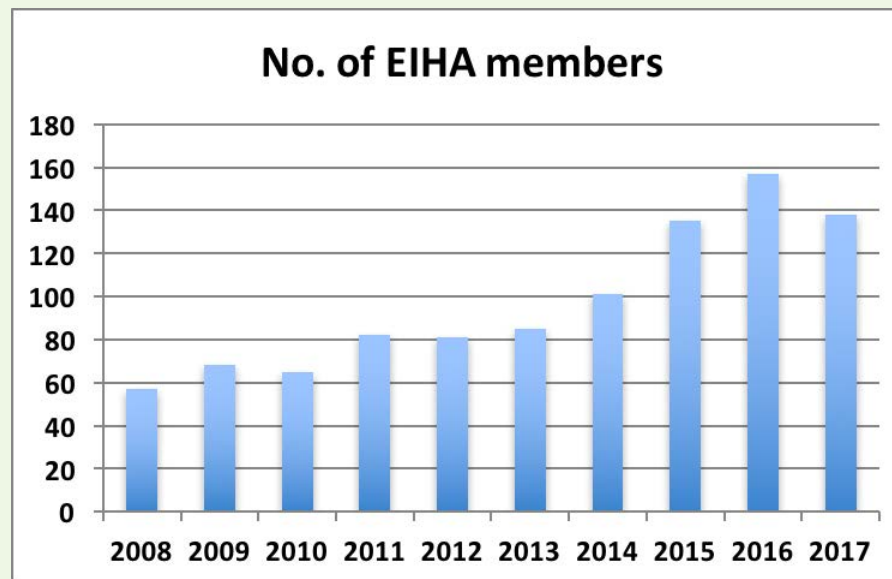

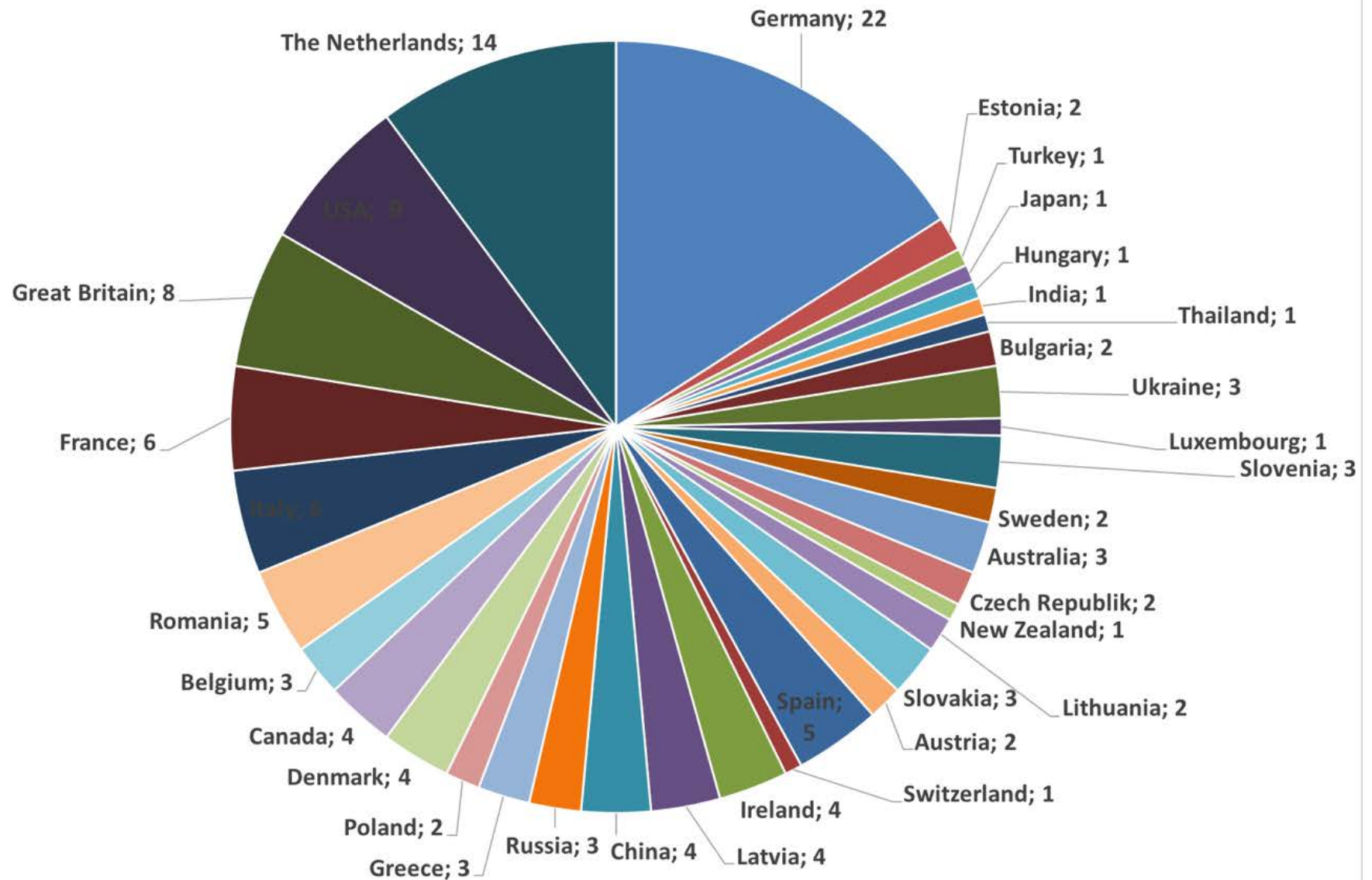

EIHA Members – country distribution

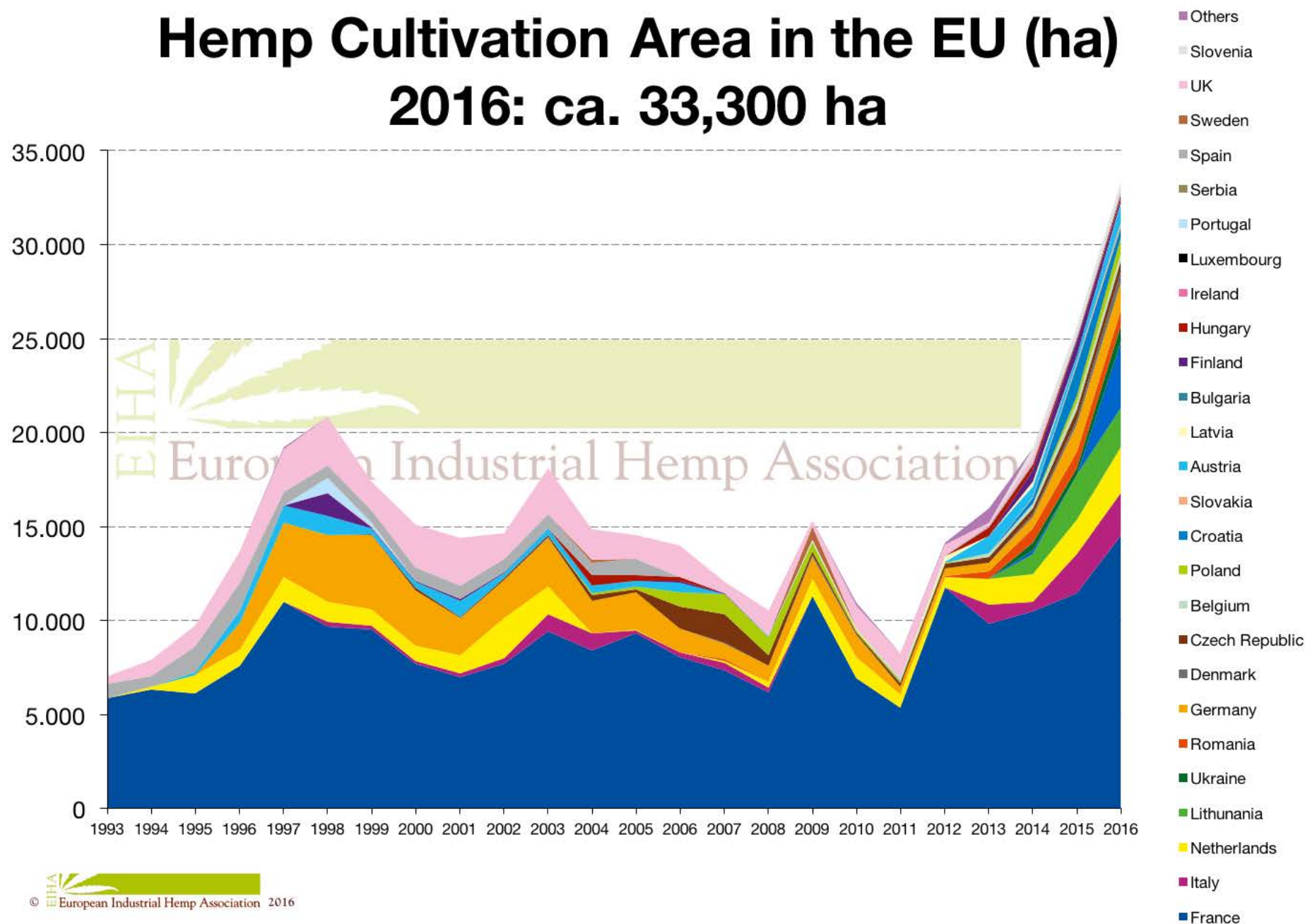

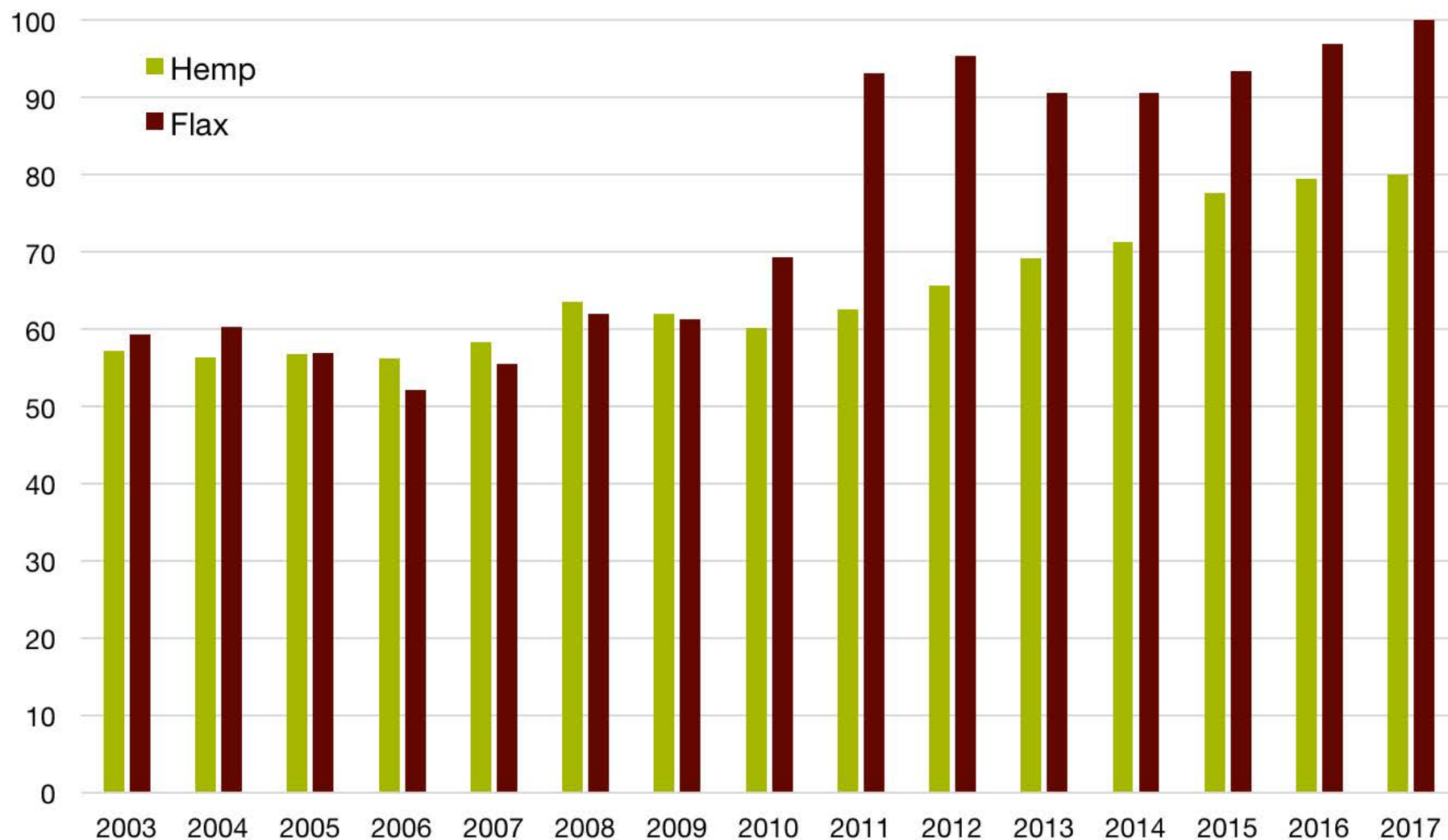


Hemp Cultivation Area in the EU (ha)

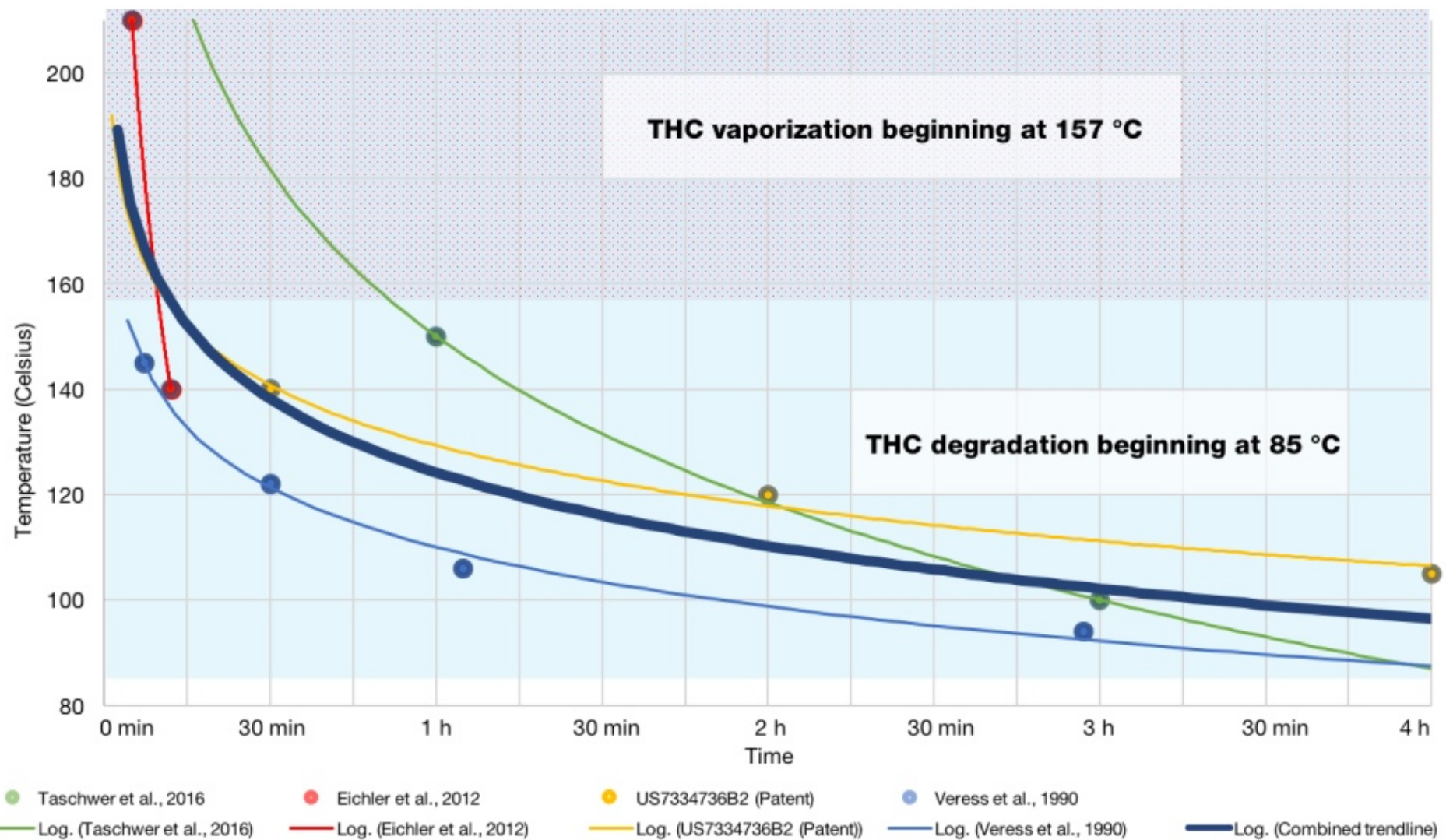

The Cologne Declaration on Industrial Hemp

**The European Industrial Hemp Association (EIHA)
Cologne (Germany), 7 June 2017**

This Declaration has been signed by the following participants of the “14th International Conference of the European Industrial Hemp Association”, 7 - 8 June 2017, Maternushaus, Cologne, Germany

Industrial hemp delivers a remarkable global performance and attracts more and more investments. Hemp is a multi-purpose crop, a biorefinery by nature, delivering fibres, shives, seeds and active plant ingredients for food supplements and pharmaceuticals at the same time.

1) Reasonable and harmonised legislation on THC guidance values for food

The signatories urge policy makers to develop a reasonable and harmonised legislation on THC guidance values for food in Europe and in all member states, to make sure that consumers are protected, to sustain the industry's current double-digit growth rate, to attract new investors, create jobs and to boost product development.

2) Reasonable and harmonised legislation on hemp extracts and non-psychoactive cannabinoids

The signatories urge policy makers to develop a reasonable and harmonised legislation on cannabinoids and hemp extracts as food supplement ingredients as well as pharmaceuticals (depending on the dose) in Europe and in all member states, to make sure that consumers are protected, to sustain the industry's current double-digit growth rate, to attract new investors, create jobs and to boost development of safe products.

3) Reasonable legislation on THC content in industrial hemp varieties

The signatories urge policy makers to create European legislation allowing for industrial hemp to possess a THC content below 0.3% in harmonisation with the rest of the world to create a level playing field especially with Canada and the USA.

4) End the ban of the cultivation of industrial hemp in the UN Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs

China Rediscovered Hemp

China Rediscovered Hemp

Hemp has attracted attention among China's scientific, political and industrial communities

China's Heilongjiang Province massively steps up its research and development efforts to make fine, environmentally friendly hemp fibres a large-scale alternative to cotton. Additionally, experts work on hemp foods and pharmaceuticals. Western companies are invited to participate in the hemp boom.



Although the cultural history of using hemp on an industrial scale can be traced back to China and the first ropes (2800 BC), papers and textiles (500 – 100 BC) ever made, hemp became sidelined a little over the past one hundred years. But that is a matter of the past now. In their search for alternatives to cotton, hemp has attracted attention among China's scientific, political and industrial communities. Cotton is increasingly causing environmental problems due to its enormous need for water, soil salinization and the use of pesticides. Neither the quality nor the price of Chinese cotton are very competitive. Last year, China

imported three million tons of cotton from the U.S., something that was unimaginable until very recently.

Given these developments, the Chinese province of Heilongjiang has decided to review the entire hemp production value chain and to produce hemp on a large industrial scale. Within only a few years, the area on which hemp is cultivated has grown from below 2,500 to more than 74,000 acres in Heilongjiang Province alone this year. This is a level of magnitude on par with the overall hemp cultivation area in Canada or Europe. If everything goes well, the area will total roughly 150,000 acres as early as next year.

In Harbin, the capital of Heilongjiang Province (located in Manchuria in the north-east of the People's Republic of China), the "2017 International Conference On Hemp Industry" (www.hempalliance.org) was held on 3 and 4 August 2017. With 300 delegates hailing from China itself as well as Australia, Europe and Canada, this was one of the largest conferences ever dedicated to hemp. The conference was supported by the local province government as well as the national Textile and Clothing Council. In their talks and the accompanying exhibition, scientists and industry representatives proudly presented their success stories to experts from all over the world.

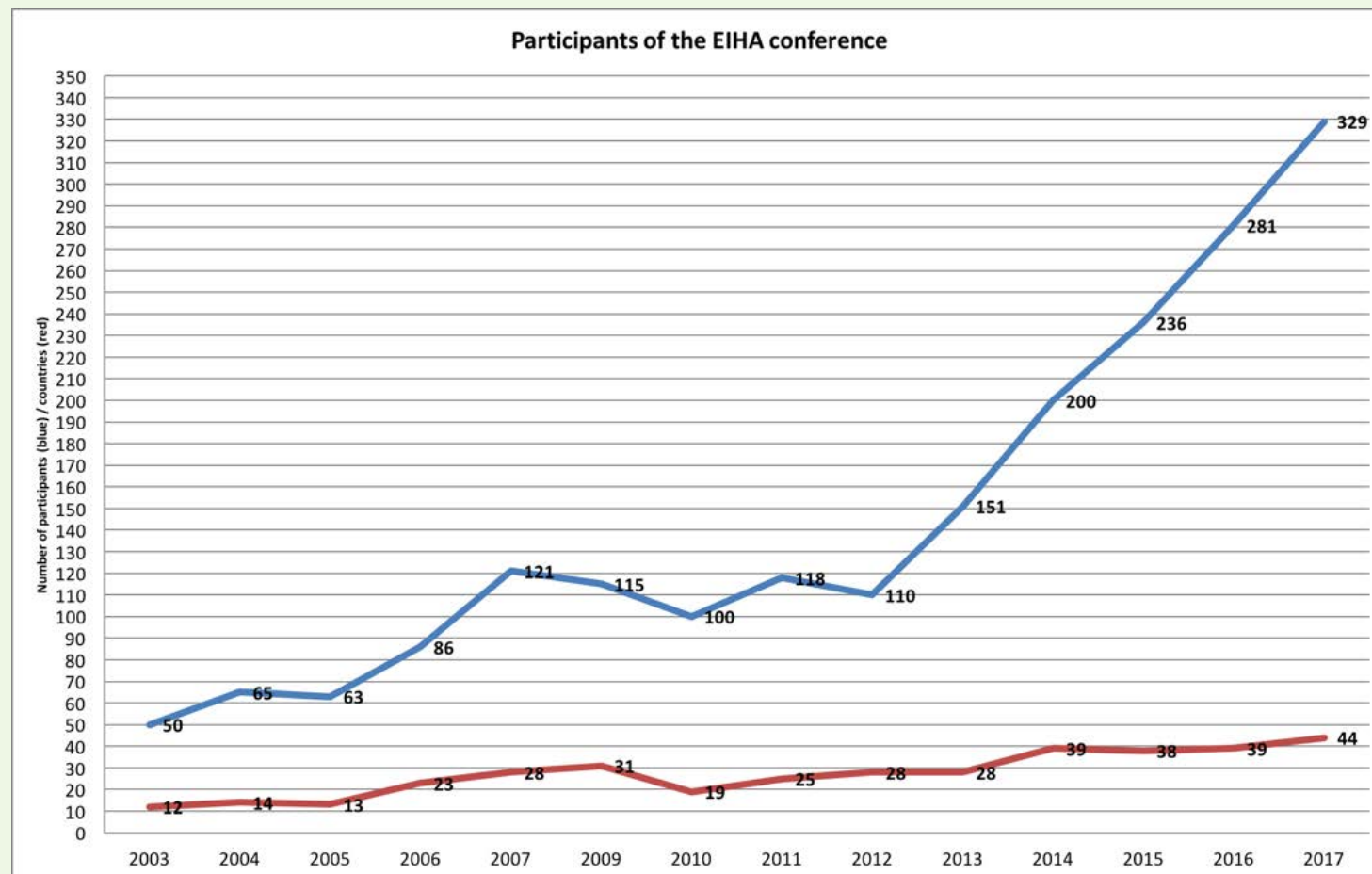

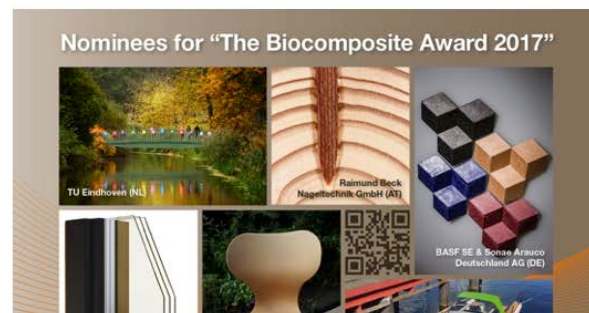

New topic in 2018: EIHA Position Paper on “THC Regulations regarding industrial hemp in the EU”

History

- **1984:** For the first time specific THC limits for industrial hemp were determined in Europe. For the marketing years until 1987 a limit of **0.5 %**, for subsequent marketing years a limit of **0.3 %** was set. "Protection of public health" was the justification for this decision.
- **1999:** The limit was lowered from **0.3 % to 0.2 %**, to prevent the cultivation of illicit drug type Cannabis in industrial hemp crops.
- In science the limit was first set to **0.5 %**, then in 1976 Small and Cronquist adopt a concentration of **0.3 %** THC (dry weight basis) to distinguish between „hemp” (non-drug Cannabis) and „marijuana” (drug Cannabis).
- In Canada and US the limit is **0.3 %** in force. No country in the world uses **0.2 %** – except the European Union.

EIHA Position Paper on “THC Regulations regarding industrial hemp in the EU”

Target

- **Restoring of the former THC limit of 0,3 % for hemp crop varieties.**

Arguments

- From a scientific point of view, there is no reason for 0.2%. In fact 0.2% are as safe as 0.3% in regards to **drug abuse** and also there will be no noticeable effect on **illicit Cannabis production** (THC 1 % – 13 %).
- The lower THC limit value in Europe alone **restricts the choice of varieties** for European farmers.
- Due to the limitation of 0.2 % THC on the field, the hemp food industry in Europe has a **significant competitive disadvantage** to producers in North America and Asia.
- With increasing hemp food markets this problem will become even bigger in subsequent years.

Respected EIHA President,
& EIHA board Members,

I would like your attention on few issues and challenges, which Global trade of Hemp are facing for your consideration.

We present these issues to EIHA as considering their decades of experience and ability to gather world wide hemp alliance together.

IIHA had its 4th Board meeting on 31st Nov. 2016 at its Head quarters PHD Chamber of Commerce (New Delhi). Various issues and challenges were discussed related to hemp.

IIHA from past 5years is working on developing hemp market in India.
From our experience working on Hemp we have faced following challenges.

It is very tough to get right information about the prices, custom duties, legalities, label requirements etc. for Hemp as raw material.

The only source of information people use world wide primarily is from Alibaba from Chinese suppliers. And often these rates vary when you actually make a purchase and sometimes the final consignment are also not as per the samples.

Which raises the question on the quality and standardisation globally.

World wide there are different laws, HS codes, and custom duties on Hemp. Because of limited information it effects the Global trade of Hemp.

India is a big market for all kind of commodities both for export and import.

In one of our case studies related to Hemp Seeds as super food we prepared a detail document comparing the Olive oil import.
Which started with merely 10Tons annually in 2000 and today the consumption has reached 15000 MT of import of Olive oil by 2017. The olive oil import in India is seeing 20% rise every year. The manufacturing companies have started investments in Spain and Italy for Olive cultivations.

Similar case studies are there for fibre. Last year Mark from Hemp Flax presented how Hemp Flax is expanding its business with cultivation of Hemp fibre in other countries and there operations, this IIHA believes is a very promising model for expansion of Hemp cultivation around the world.

3-06-2017

Hemp around the world face challenges regarding THC limits and cultivation which also hinders the expansion and utilisation of Hemp by main stream industries. So far because of less global trade, primarily SME and Micro level industries nationally are in the Hemp business.

IIHA was contacted by various Embassies related to legalities and provisions for Hemp import in India.

We also consulted Malawi Embassy the benefits of Hemp at Indo - Africa summit in India 2015. Which helped company like Invigrow to start the trials in Malawi.

Every countries Government they look for good foreign trade market and if there is huge demand the government do take initiate in supporting the particular trade.

We all have national associations where we are restricted to our countries and its affairs with our set of own rules and regulations concentrating primarily disseminating informations to our members.

Thus IIHA propose there should be a Global Forum or Committee consisting of International authentic associations and organisation one from each country as board members and one chairperson or president to regulate the global hemp industry for hemp trade growth around the world and expanding the Hemp market.

The Hemp Global Forum or Committee should be incharge of addressing the issues related to ongoing prices, availability of raw material, legalities, promotion and awareness of hemp world wide.

This will insure the quality, fare price value, eliminating doubts on legalities and expansion of hemp market at global level.

Now I will leave this proposal with EIHA President and board members for consideration and discussion.

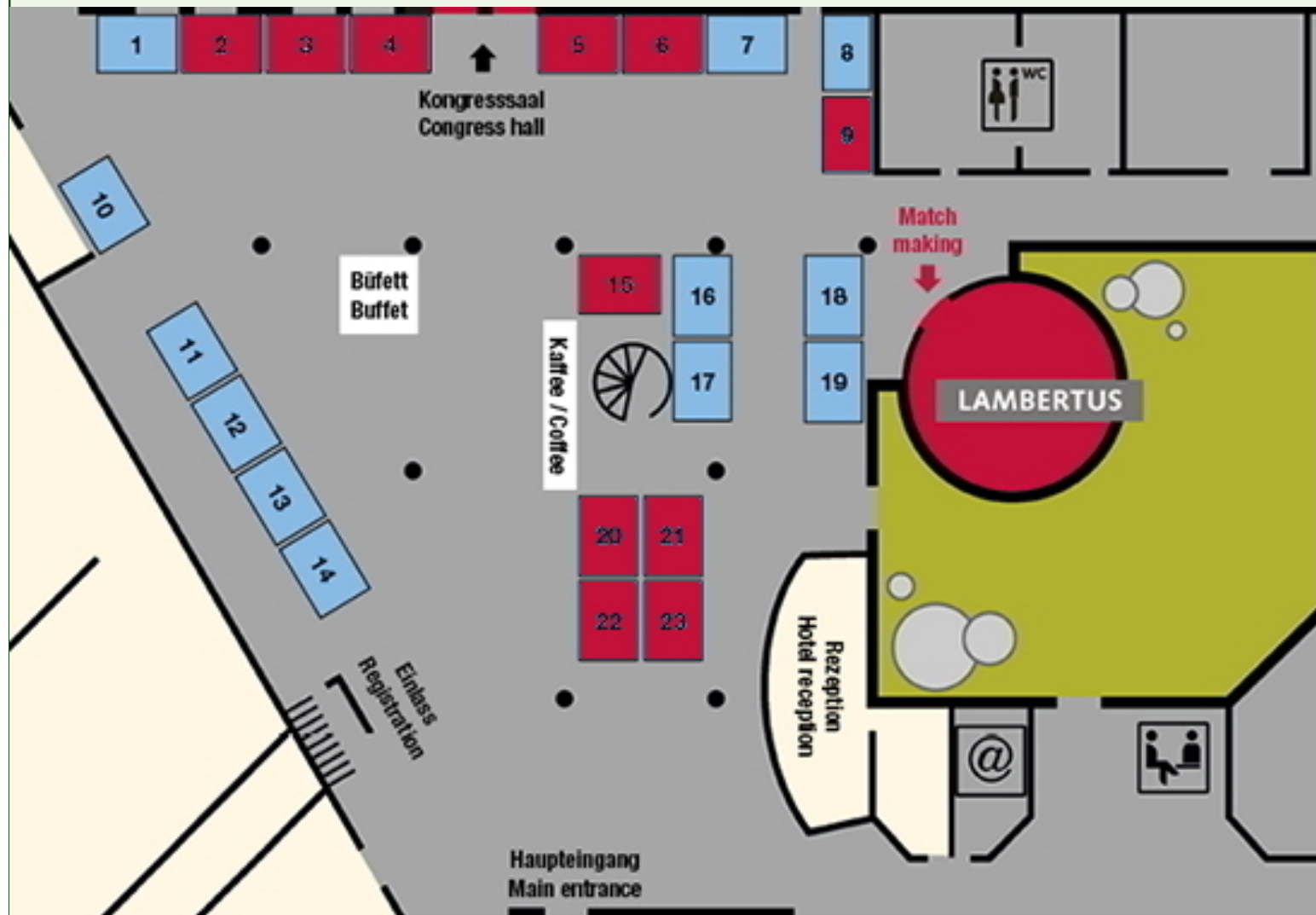

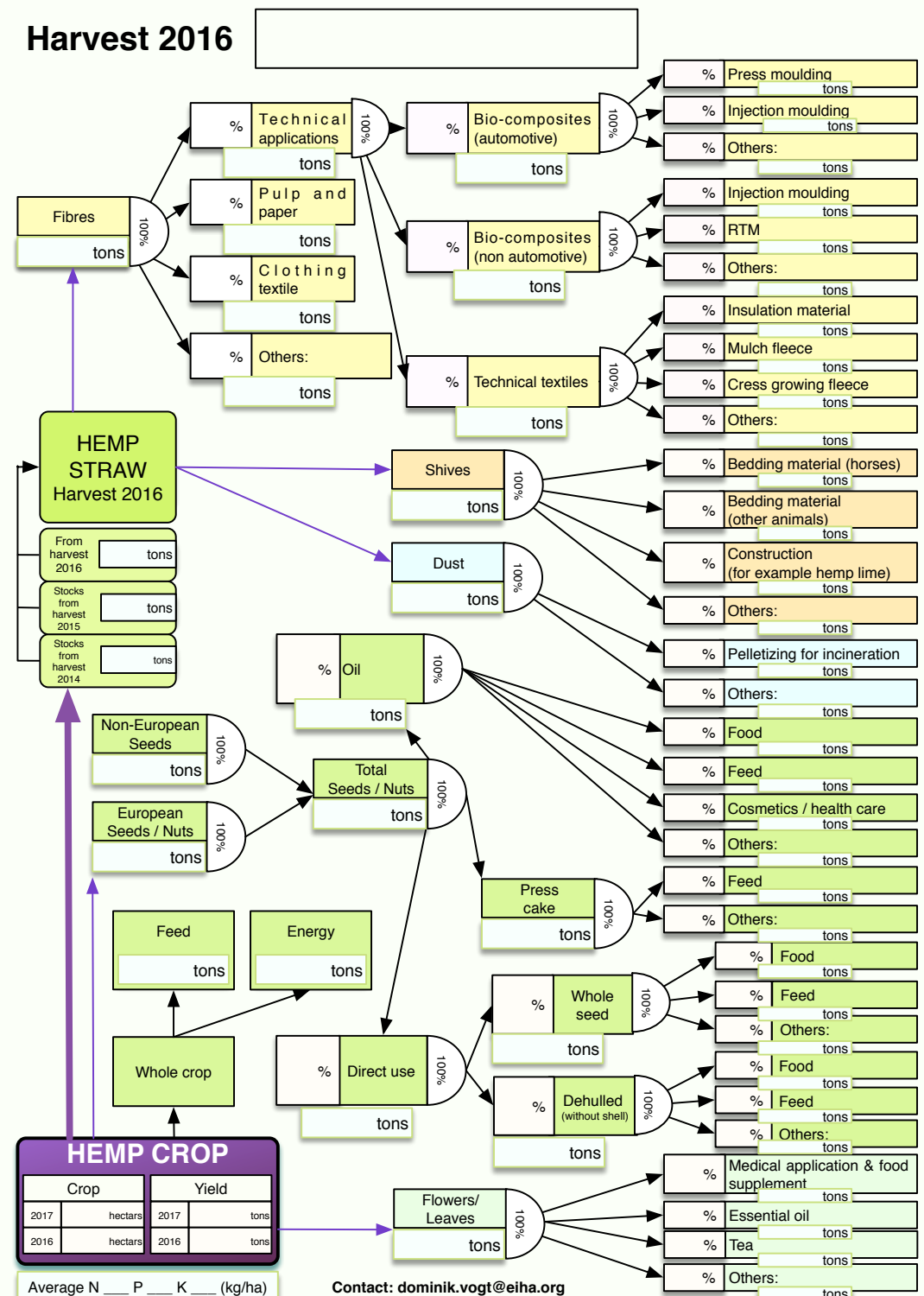
